GUIDELINES

The rules of the Garden:

I will not interfere with the rights and opportunities of others using the Garden.

I will carry away rubbish and dispose of it off the Garden.

When using tools I will be aware of the safety of others and myself, and always put them back.

I will be responsible for the supervision of any children I bring into the Garden.

I will not bring any dogs into the Garden.

I understand that my participation at the Garden is at my own risk. The Garden is not liable for any injury to me, my invited friends, nor the loss of any of my possessions.

I appreciate the need for security of the Garden and will report any suspicious activity.

I will aim to follow organic gardening principles where possible for the management of pests and diseases.

I will not plant any weed species identified in the DEC 'Weeds of the South West Region' document.

I will help to maintain weed free pathways and garden beds.

I will follow the guidelines regarding the use of the composting facility.

I will respect the decisions of the Garden Committee.

I will show respect to the Garden and to others working at the Garden and not be abusive or disruptive.

I will follow the committee's guidelines regarding planting and harvesting produce.
